

2025 Selma to Montgomery March

Sunday, March 9, 2025

- Bloody Sunday March and Events
- Skipping traditional first leg of the March

Monday March 10, 2025

- March starts at 9 AM at US Hwy 80 at Mile Marker 88.5, just east of the intersection of US Hwy 80 and US/AL 41 South.
- First stop – Mile Marker 90.3. Landmark = gas station on Hwy 80
- Second stop/lunch – Mile Marker 93.2. Southside High School.
- Third stop – Mile Marker 96.3 at County Road 7. Landmark = Tyler Post Office.
- Last stop at 3 PM at Mile Marker 100 in the Benton City Limits and Lowndes County line. NOTE: March can also end at the Warren Oil and Industrial Park at Mile Marker 99 to shorten the March by a mile.
- March = 10.5 or 11.5 miles.

Tuesday, March 11, 2025

- March starts at 9 AM at Mile Marker 100 – Benton City Limits and Lowndes County Line.
- First stop – Mile Marker 102.1. Citgo Gas Station
- Second mini break – Mile Marker 104 on right shoulder of Hwy 80 at top of the hill
- Third stop/lunch – Mile Marker 106 at Lowndes County Interpretive Center. NOTE: The big parking lot of White Hall Entertainment across from the Interpretive Center on Hwy 80 is also available for the break, and we can have tables and food set up in advance there.
- Fourth stop = Mile Marker 109.7 at the top of the hill, right of way past Big Swamp Bridge.
- Last stop at 3pm = Mile Marker 111 – Viola Liuzzo Monument/Church to right Hwy 80.
- March = 11 miles.

Wednesday, March 12, 2025

- Begin at Mile Marker 111 – Viola Liuzzo Monument/Church
- First stop – Mile Marker 113.2 at BP Station on the right of Hwy 80.
- Second stop/lunch – Mile Marker 116.3/Canaan Hill Church on right of Hwy 80.
- Third stop – Mile Marker 118.5 – BP Station
- Last stop at 3 PM – Mile Marker 119.6. Church of Christ. That Church of Christ parking lot is a good space to hold press conference for that day.
- Alternate last stop: Mile Marker 121, also known as the end of the Wednesday March in the past.
- March = 8.6 miles (or 10 miles if the alternate last stop is utilized).

Thursday, March 13, 2025

- Begin at 9 AM at Mile Marker 121.6 at Burkville Memorial Methodist Church on right of Hwy 80.
- First stop – Mile Marker 124.1 – on right shoulder of Hwy 80 across from MTW Arrowspace located at 7050 Selma Hwy, Montgomery, AL 36108
- Second stop/lunch – Mile Marcher 126.1 – Citgo Gas Station right before the Montgomery Airport and at the Montgomery City Limits
- Third stop – Mile Marker 128.3 Fire Station #14 (need to confirm escort by Montgomery Police Department).
- With police: Exit Hwy 80 to US Highway 31 North Turn Left on Hwy 31 N and Mobile Hwy. Travel 2 miles on Mobile Hwy, turn into W Fairview Ave. Travel 2 miles on W Fairview Ave. to the parking lot across from former St. Jude's Educational Institute 2080 W Fairview Ave.
- Last stop at 3 PM – The parking lot of the Old Calhoun Food Store at the Corner of West Fairview and Oak Street (across from old City of St. Jude).
- March = 11 miles..

Friday, March 14, 2025

- March starts at 9 AM in the parking lot of the Old Calhoun Food Store at the Corner of West Fairview and Oak Street (across from old City of St. Jude). Travel 4 miles to Alabama State Capitol, 600 Dexter Ave. Montgomery. State Capitol Rally at 11 AM. March = 4 miles.

Friday, March 14, 2025 Specifics:

- March Down Oak St. from parking lot of old Calhoun Superfoods across from the former City of St. Jude at 2080n W. Fairview Avenue
- Turn Right onto W Fred D Gray Ave
- Turn Left onto S Holt St.
- Turn Right onto Day St
- Turn Left onto Mobile St which will become Montgomery St
- Make right onto S. Court St
- Circle left around the Court Square Fountain onto Dexter Ave
- Continue on Dexter Ave till the front of the Capitol for Rally.
- March = 4 miles.
